The clip has been designed to replace the broken thread OR lug on the inside of the back box.

After a few simple adjustments to the inside of the back box, **by removing all snags**, the clip simply pushes on with ease and remains firmly and securely in place. Within minutes the box is repaired speedily and with very little mess.

Installation Guide:

-Ensure power is isolated.

-Remove the face plate.

-Remove the broken/damaged lug using pliers, or a hammer and chisel/screwdriver to gently tap any snags outwards so the clip cannot foul. If the box twists out of shape, try straighten it as best you can.

-Using a sharp tool, scrape away any plaster or adhesive from the outside edge of the box in the area where the clip is to be located, so the back of the clip has room to be pushed on.

-Using the nose of a set of pliers or a suitable tool, push the clip in to place (DO NOT HAMMER).

-Screw the face plate back to the wall, ensuring not to overtighten.
